Betty Lee (Parrish) Betscher 70, of Enon passed away on Nov. 29, 2014, supported by her loving family through her battle with cancer. She was born in Alexandria, VA to Paul and Imogene Parrish. She graduated from Greenon High School in 1961 and completed Fredrick's Beauty Academy. She was a beautician 5 years, and then was employed at WPAFB in the Foreign Technology National Air and Space Intelligence Center 46 years, retiring May 3, 2013.
