And he retorted oh it's just a nickname and I said well what's your real name and he said Brian but you can just call me ASAP and I said okay. And I turned around as I was doing dishes and Megan said Nani we have a question to ask and I said yes and she said can ASAP stay with us for a while? I at this time had already taken in two boys and one girl from the streets plus my own family of Jason Noah Samuel Elijah Gabriel Michelle Megan and my little baby great grandson Kingston. Little did I know that night would bring a bond between the two of us that has lasted all these years. I saw ASAP in many different lights at my house sadness, confusion, depression, happiness, loneliness, but no matter what his mood was he always had love for all of us in my home and especially my granddaughter Megan and baby Kingston who would come to call him floppy because he never could say his name LOL. Many times I would sit down with ASAP and Noah and tell them what they were doing wouldn't have a good ending would cause them much trouble but no matter how many times I would have that talk with them it was always Nani okay we've done it a hundred times we'll be fine don't worry we're going to quit however that never happened of course. And then ASAP went to prison but the most wonderful thing about knowing that he was there was knowing he was always safe and away from harm. Even through prison days every Sunday I could count on a phone call before church or after church and he always always started our conversation with hi Nani how are you are you okay is there anything that I can help you with and I would laugh and say how are you going to help me he said Nani I'll find a way even if I'm in here I'll find a way and we would talk and at the end of every conversation on Sunday morning he would say when I get out of here I'm going to change I'm going to do things different I'm not going to be that same person who gets in trouble I'm going to make it good for Megan and me. And I would say I'm holding you to that promise you better do it and he'd laugh and say I will. And then when he called me to let me know he had gotten out we were FaceTiming and I said to him now remember remember your promise that promise is not just to me that promise is to yourself and you are the only one who can make that promise come true. And he said I'm going to do it I'm going to do it this time Nani I'm going to make a difference and I'm going to change. And after that I would speak to ASAP time and time again when he visit Megan or he would visit my daughter Michelle and I would remind him of his promise and tell him what are you doing remember what you wanted remember you needed this to be a better person don't do this don't fall in the same trap and of course as usual that infectious smile and those twinkling eyes would look at me and say I know Nani I love you I'm going to do it.
