



## Clifford Lee Harmon

February 3, 1930 - March 21, 2023

Clifford L. Harmon, 93, of Springfield, passed away peacefully and went to be with the Lord on Tuesday, March 21, 2023 at his home, succumbing to slowly failing health the past year. He was born February 3, 1930, the youngest of seven children, spending his early years in the Morehead, Kentucky area. Clifford served in the U.S. Army during 1951-53.

Clifford was preceded in death by his wife of forty-five years, Carol Diane Harmon, three sisters, Alice Loraine Harmon, Hannah Margaret Cameron, and Elizabeth Pursley, and three brothers, Jay Harmon, Willie Harmon and Charles Harmon.
