Jane Ellen Curry was born on February 15, 1953 in Kankakee, IL to Coy and Fleta (Creek) Lentz. She was 66 years old when she passed from this life on July 5, 2019. She was preceded in death by her parents. She is survived by her husband, Larry J. Curry, whom she married on November 10, 1972 in Bradley, IL. She is also survived by two sons, Jason D. Curry (wife Andrea) of San Jose, CA and Timothy J. Curry (wife Martha) of Franklin, IN. Also surviving are two grandsons, Titus P. Curry and Ezekiel V. Curry, both of Franklin, IN, one sister, Nancy Lentz of Fairborn, OH, and numerous cousins.

Jane adored her husband, loved her family, cherished her brothers and sisters in Christ. She retired from Purdue University on May 1, 2013 after eighteen years. Above all, she was a Christian who dedicated her life to teaching others the Gospel of Christ. She loved being a preacher's wife, having home Bible studies and studies by telephone while she struggled with her cancer. 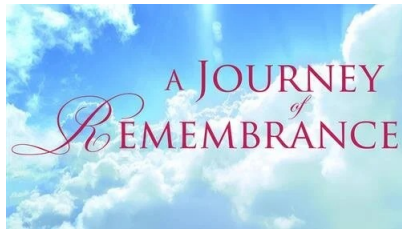
