Mr. Landrum passed peacefully in his sleep after a lengthy illness. He was preceded by his wife, Mary Jane (Rice) Landrum (11/17/41-9/14/2009). He is survived by their son John and daughter-in-law Linda Peacock-Landrum, daughter Jeanne Adams and son-in-law George Adams, and daughter Julie VanHoose and son-in-law David VanHoose. He also has eight grandchildren, Jake (Allie), Abbi, Brian (Jennifer), Sherri, Kenny, Chris (Brittany), Sarah (Justin), and Lauren (Tim). He also has nine great grandchildren and a great many nieces and nephews.

Johnny was the seventh child and first son of 14 children born to (Robert) Clester Landrum and Martha Ellen (Murphy) Landrum in Menifee County, Kentucky. He was preceded also by his sisters and brothers-in-law Elsie (Marion Hollon), Mary (Denn Smallwood) and Inez (Remus Hounshell) and brothers -in-law Edgar Raney, Wilbur Rudd, Beecher Hines, and Clifford Stevens. He is survived by his brothers and sisters Francis Napier, Reva Raney, Lilly Stevens, Ruby Hines, Edna Rudd, Robert (Wilma), Warren (Sue), Ottis (Virginia), Everett (Connie), and Betty (Donnie Spencer).

Johnny moved from Kentucky to Moraine, Ohio in 1955, and married in 1957. He moved his family to Springfield, Ohio in 1968. He worked mainly as a truck

driver, first for Price Brothers and then for Arkansas Best Freight (ABF), where he was a member of the Teamsters.

Johnny was a 51 year member of the Masonic Lodge 421 in Yellow Springs, Ohio, was an avid hunter and fisherman in his free time, and enjoyed time spent in his garden each year as well. Family was important to him and he was a loyal and supportive husband, father, grandfather, son, brother, and brother-in-law.

A private family ceremony will be held at the Landrum Family cemetery in Pomeroyton, Kentucky, in late May of this year.
