

Jonah Hensley Jr.

May 29, 1934 - December 7, 2022

Jonah Hensley, Junior, age 88 of Enon Ohio, passed away Wednesday December 7, 2022. He was born May 29, 1934 on Sutton Branch, Clay County KY, to the late Joney and Otha Hensley. Jonah at 17, entered and proudly served 20 years, then retired from active duty in the United States Air Force. He worked another 15 years at Wright-Patterson AFB as a civil servant in the heating plant, where he retired at the age of 51. Jonah as a veteran served in Korea, Puerto Rico, and at several bases in the United States where his five children were born, finally settling in Enon.

Jonah loved his wife Louise, children and family. He enjoyed gardening, cutting grass, camping, fishing and most of all cooking for family and friends. He was devoted to God and attending church throughout his life.

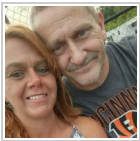

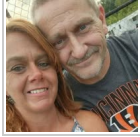

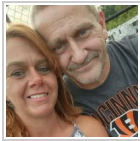
