We'll meet again one day!

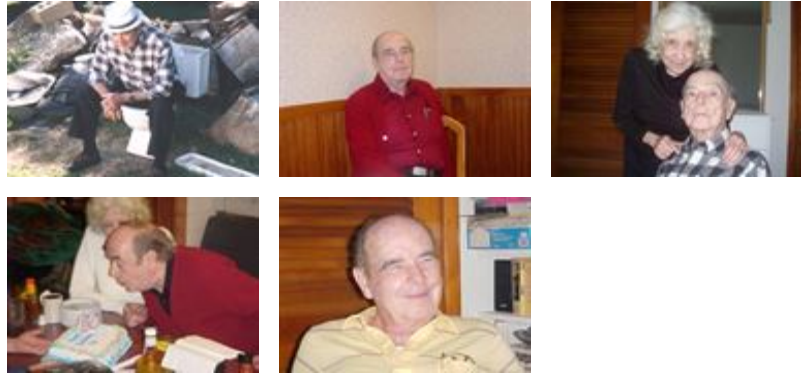
