Katherine (Kay, Katie) Buryl Johnson Bandura, 98, formerly of Enon and Kettering, Ohio passed on Monday, August 14, 2023 in Niceville, Florida. Born in Red Bush, Kentucky on July 22, 1925, the fifth of ten children to Charles and Clara Johnson, she spent her early years in Hillsboro, Ohio where she graduated from high school in 1943. Kay married John Bandura, the love of her life, on January 21, 1947 in Dayton, Ohio. She had many talents, employed as a Human Resources specialist, operating a greenhouse with her husband and parents and working as a librarian and tutor at the local school. She was an avid, award-winning, gardener, quilter, hiker and volunteer – donating over 1,000 hours of her time to the city of Kettering, Ohio. Kay adored people and loved gathering with family and friends. She was extremely energetic, tenacious and very active in the lives of her family – coming to help with any situation when called. Until her dying day, she was quick witted with an enduring sense of humor – giving sound advice and always having the last word. Kay adored her grandson and was very involved in his life – helping with school projects, attending sporting events and school functions, and cheering him on in all of his pursuits.
