Keith was an Army Veteran and retired from W.P.A.F.B. Keith was a member of the American Legion Post 526. He was especially proud to have made a trip to Washington DC on the Honor Flight for veterans to experience the memorials of those who sacrificed all for our country. Keith enjoyed travelling and was fortunate to sail on the Queen Elizabeth II to Europe and return as one of 100 people on the Concorde supersonic transport when it made its only trip to Dayton. Keith is survived by his close friend, Robert Lear of Dayton, numerous relatives, and a wide circle of friends. He was preceded in death by his parents, longtime companion Dayton Calloway, stepfather, James English, and a sister, Barbara Sue Hartley.
