Larry David Preston, age 70, of Springfield (formerly of Yellow Springs) went to his new home on Thursday, February 02, 2017. He was born on December 24, 1946 to Luther Preston and Leone (Osborne) Preston in Paintsville, KY. His family moved to Ohio in 1956 where Larry graduated from Greenon High School in 1966. He met the love of his life and married Patricia (Damron) Preston on April 29, 1967. Larry worked for IH/Navistar until 1980, when he became disabled. Larry enjoyed becoming a master wood worker throughout his life and has lots of friends in that community. He was born again in Christ at age 17 and has been a member of Miami Valley United Baptist Church ever since. He was a deacon for the church for several decades.
