Llewellyn “Lew” Darrel Parsons, 85 of Enon passed away Monday, August 29, 2016 in Hospice of Dayton. He was born November 12, 1930 in Live Oak, California to the late Forest and Grace Parsons. Lew retired as HMC after 20 yrs serving in the U.S. Navy in the Korea and Vietnam Wars. He last served on the DD-838 E.G. Small where he is still respectfully known by his shipmates as “Doc.” He was always proud to also serve as a Hospital Corpsman for the Marines. After retiring from the Navy, he worked another 20 yrs until retiring as a health inspector for the city of Springfield. He was a life member of the George Rogers V.F.W. Post 8437.
