Lew was born in Auburn, NY on 17 September 1946 to William (Bill) Marvin (Marve) Arnold and Frances (Fran) Davis Arnold. The joy and pride of his life was his best friend, soulmate, and wife, Kathryn Sue Colwell Arnold, the best thing to ever happen to him. From 1972 through 2004 he covered multiple Greenon sports for the various incarnations of the Enon newspaper. He was also active in the Enon community and was serving on the Enon Village Council. He especially enjoyed watching his children and grandchildren in their involvement in various sports, particularly soccer, cross country, and track. Survivors include his wife; their sons Joshua Colwell Arnold and Caleb

Matthew Arnold; their daughter Laura Kim Arnold Williams, her husband Mike, and their children Cody and Kaylee; brother Thomas Marvin Arnold, his wife Kathy, and their sons Andy, Michael, and Tony; and sister Marcia Louise Arnold Brown, her husband Kelly, and their children Ross, Neil, and Maggie; and his mother-in-law, Mary Kathryn (Oma) Colwell.
