“ Charlotte and Jenny and Family,

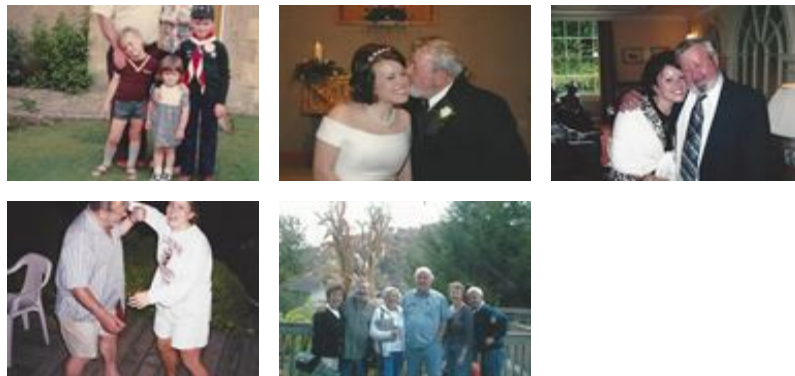

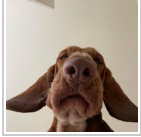
