Nancy Carol Vanderglas, 84, of Enon passed away Monday, February 1, 2021 in Centerville. She was born January 25, 1937 in Etna, Pennsylvania to the late Conrad Edward and Harriet Bergman. Nancy was one of the owners of the Yellow Tulip Children's Book Store in Yellow Springs, an early education teacher who taught in the Springfield and Yellow Springs School systems. She was a past president of the Women's Medical Auxiliary, and a member of the Clark County Master Gardeners. Nancy is survived by her four children: Cindy and Dick Gould of Xenia, Joel and Kim Vanderglas of Bowling Green, Kentucky, Brian and Rosie Vanderglas of Austin, Texas, and Jon Vanderglas and Shelley Wiley of Enon. She has three siblings, Margie Funk, Ken Bergman, and Jim and Carol Bergman. She has eight grandchildren, Gretchen, Luke, Heidi, Justin, Bradley, Hope, Jake, and Max, and four great-grandchildren, Henryk, Huxley, Ophelia, and Kipton, as well as numerous nieces, nephews, and friends. 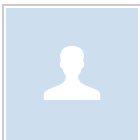
