



Stephen "Steve" W. Trout

November 30, 1946 - December 22, 2017

Trout, Stephen "Steve" W., 71, of Enon passed away unexpectedly on December 22, 2017. Steve was born November 30, 1946 to Lt. Max D. Trout (deceased) and Doris "Dot" Trout (Roe) in Augsburg, Germany. Graduated from Paris-American High School, Paris, France; attended the University of Maryland, Munich, Germany campus and Wright State University. Steve married the love of his life, Katherine A. Trout, on June 8, 1968 in Cleveland, Ohio. Served in the U.S. Army, Steve was stationed in Ulm, Germany with the Pershing Missile Unit. Upon his return stateside, Steve began his professional career in finance at Beneficial Finance, retiring in 2015 from Castrucci Auto Mall as Finance Director. Steve's heart truly was in Enon - for 21 ½ years Steve served the Village of Enon; first, as Clerk Treasurer, then as a member of Council and Council President for several years. Steve was an avid reader, visiting one of his most favorite places in the village, The Enon Library. He always looked forward to being with the 9 a.m. Sunday morning stirrers at the annual Enon Apple Butter Festival. Saturday mornings were strictly reserved for, as Steve called it, the breakfast "board meetings" with close life-long friends. The OSU Buckeyes football team was his absolute favorite. Golf was his passion, and was so elated when he scored that 'hole in one' at Greene Country Club. Steve loved the outdoors – planning his garden, planting that patch of wildflowers, hanging strands of colored Christmas lights on the big Colorado blue spruce. Steve was most proud of his family - so loved his wife, son, daughter, and especially his 3 grandchildren, who had no bigger fan than

their 'Grandpa' cheering them on at a variety of their sporting events. His grandchildren were the light of his life. Steve is survived by his beloved wife of 49 ½ years, Kathy; his daughter, Stefanie and James Patsiavos of Hilliard, Ohio; his son, Christopher and Megan Trout of Oakwood, Ohio. His mother, Dot Trout of South Pasadena, Florida. Brothers: Thomas (Katherine S.) Trout of Springfield, Ohio; R. Andrew (Mary) Trout of Pueblo, Colorado. Three grandchildren: Maxwell Patsiavos, Evan Trout and Stella Patsiavos. Cousins, Terry Sweet, Peggy Gamber and their families along with numerous nieces, nephews and many close friends. Steve was a member of the Enon VFW, Masonic Lodge 421 in Yellow Springs, Scottish Rite, Antioch Shrine, Moose and Elks. 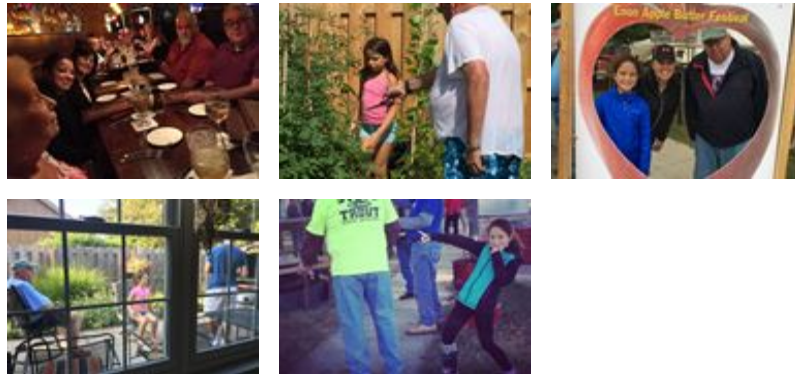

“ On Sgt Trout, where do I begin? You were my best friend and confidant during our Army days in Germany. I was fascinated with your knowledge of all things military due to your growing up in the Air Force in Europe, and your many experiences while doing so. The memories are endless and they are all good. From all the times you went out of your way on cold winter mornings to pick me up in your VW Beetle on your way to Wiley Barracks since I did not have a car, to all the foosball games we won with you always on the goal handles and with me up front (I think it took 6 months for my "foosball calluses to recede off my hands after we got out of the Army), to our TDY time in Frankfurt when we went together to a Doors concert and stood right next to the stage, and you getting kicked off a street car because you didn't buy a ticket and I did, to the time we were on combat alert status and the two of us were sent to retrieve a replacement track vehicle that I was driving and you were supposed to be my "walk in front guide" at night when it was really dark in the forest when as soon as we got out of eye sight of the brass, I stopped and you jumped up on the front of the track and now with no guide, I side swiped a 5/4 truck parked on the side of the unlit gravel road causing a paintless streak all along the side (we didn't report it and no one ever said a thing about it), and of course, the day we were sweating bullets when we appeared before a board of Sr non commissioned officers and the battalion Sr officers to see if we were worthy of becoming sergeants which of course we were, to the time we met after our Army days in Salina, KS where you dropped the lens cap to your camera down into the sacred graves of the native American's we were viewing. I have always wished we lived closer to each other in our post military lives so that we could have spent a LOT more time together with you and your wonderful wife (the second Mom to my daughter when she was born in Augsburg, Germany, your birthplace probably in the same military hospital). I miss you already Sgt Trout. God Speed.
