Thomas G. Farrell, 81, of Springfield passed away Saturday, February 4, 2017 in Springfield. Thomas was born November 10, 1935 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania to the late Lewis J. and Olive M. Farrell Jr.

Thomas graduated from the University of North Carolina with a B.A. in English and was commissioned in the United States Air Force upon completion of the Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps program. He received a subsequent B.S. degree in Aeromechanical Engineering from the Air Force Institute of Technology at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base and a M.S. in Research and Development Systems Management from the University of Southern California. A Professional Engineer, Thomas served in the U.S.A.F. for 21 years, managing numerous weapon system development projects. He retired as a Lieutenant Colonel. After his military service, Thomas went on to manage several aerospace engineering firms before starting his own business. He remained an entrepreneur until the day he died.

Thomas had a great sense of humor and enjoyed swimming and gardening. A lifelong learner, he enjoyed many hobbies over the years, including drawing and painting, wine making, beekeeping, banjo playing, sailing, shortwave radio, and civilian aviation. He was studying Computer Aided Design (CAD) programs in his last days. Always optimistic about the future, he saw, learned, and experienced the rapid technological advances of his day. Shayla, his wife of 43 years, preceded him in death. Thomas is survived by his two sons, Thomas G. Farrell Jr of Frederick, Maryland and David R. Farrell of Springfield, and a brother, Edward J. Farrell. Memorial service will be conducted 7:00 pm Friday, February 10, 2017 in Adkins Funeral Home in Enon, Ohio with a visitation held one hour prior to the service in the funeral home. www.adkinsfunerals.com
