



## William "Bill" or "Bud" Campbell

William "Bill" or "Bud" H. Campbell, 85, of Springfield, passed away on Friday, February 26, 2021 in his home. 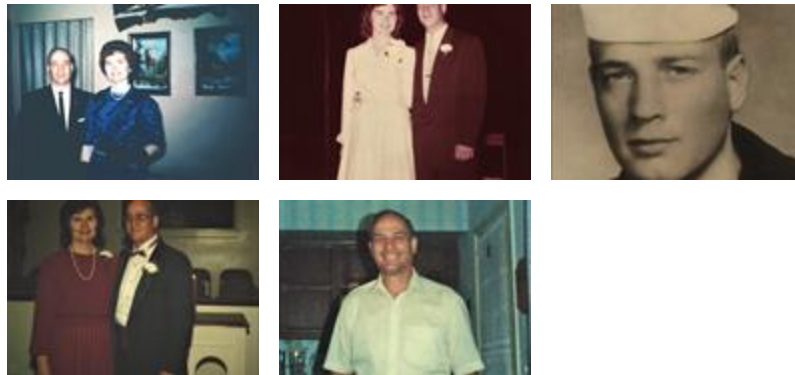
