



William "Bill" Harry Ehrgott

April 25, 1924 - January 3, 2013

William (Bill) Harry Ehrgott, 88, of Springfield, Ohio passed away peacefully January 3, 2013 at Friends Care Center of Yellow Springs surrounded by his family. Bill was born April 25, 1924 in Owatonna, Minnesota, the only child of Harry Jacob and Ethel (Hubbell) Ehrgott. He grew up in Dayton, Ohio and graduated from Parker Cooperative High School in 1942.
